### Yeovil QRP Rally Report 12 April 2015

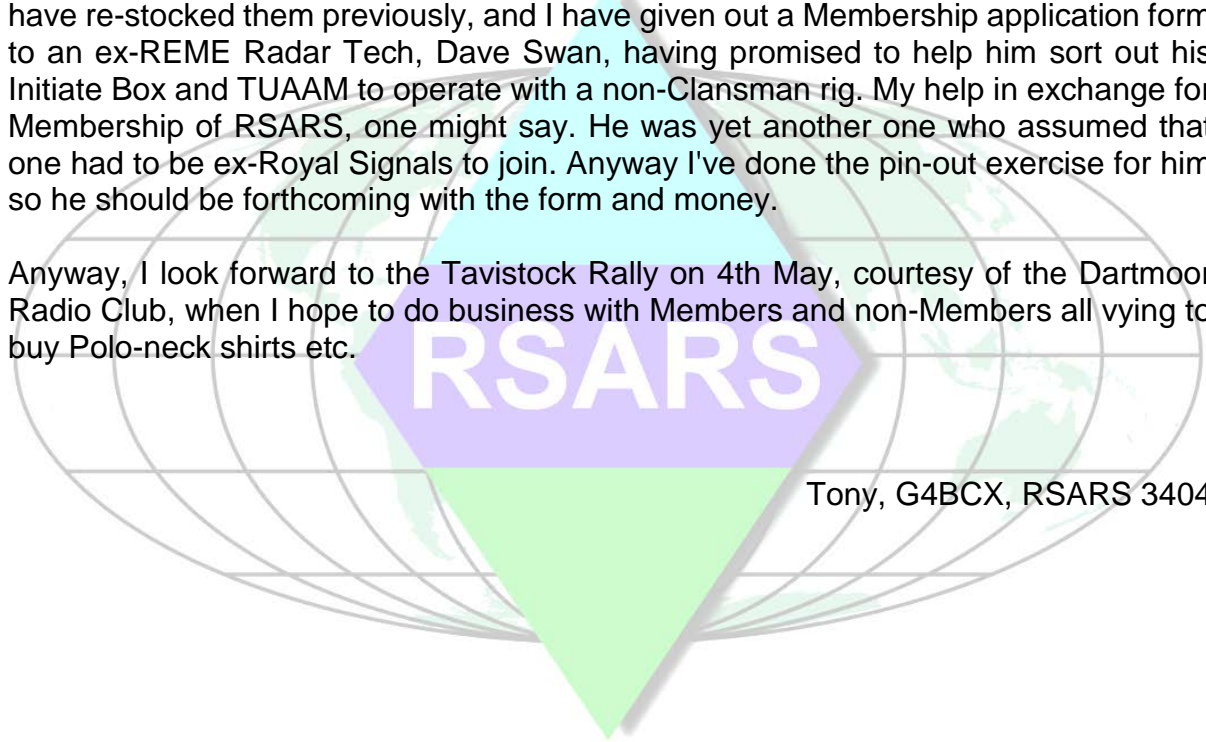
